Reverend Osmar O. Lehenbauer was born in Brazil, South America, the son of missionary parents. He graduated from Concordia Seminary, Springfield, Illinois in 1954. Before coming to Immanuel in 1986, he served as associate pastor and then senior pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Chicago Heights for a total of 16 ½

years. He was married to the former Shirlee Rieck, and had four children: Rebecca, Joel, Dan and Eric. Among the offices held by Reverend Lehenbauer were: doctrinal reviewer for the Missouri Synod Board of Parish Education; vice president of Northern Illinois District and member of the Board of Regents of Concordia College, River Forest, Illinois. Reverend Lehenbauer received the "Servus Ecclesiae Christi" award from Fort Wayne Seminary in 1978. In 1991, he was elected president of the New England District of the Missouri Synod. He then became the third pastor from Immanuel to be elected to that office.
