STEWARDSHIP BIBLE VERSE FOR MARCH 26, 2017

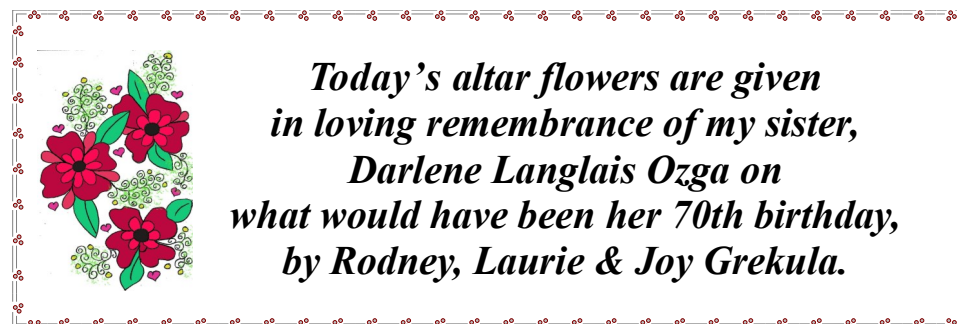
