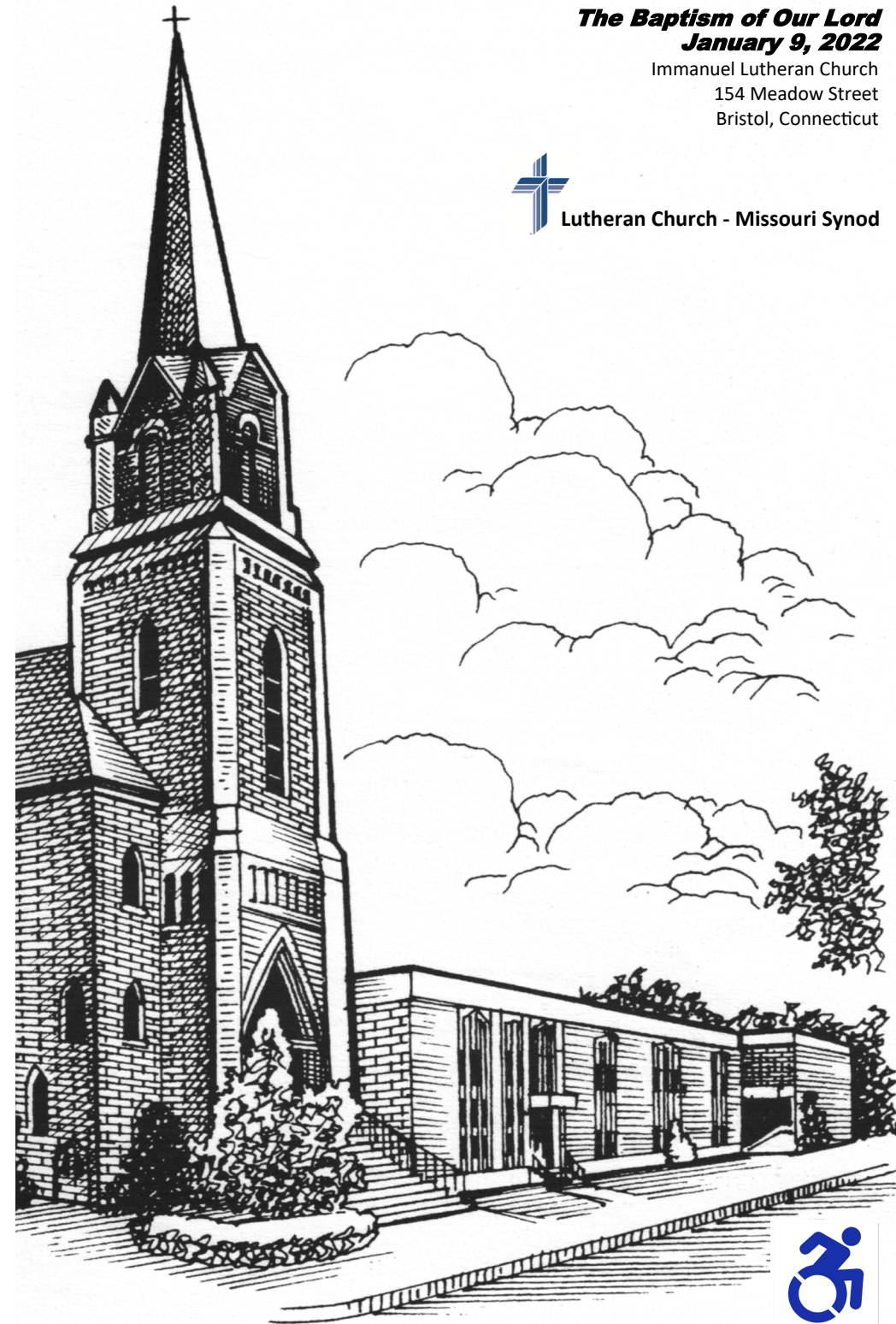

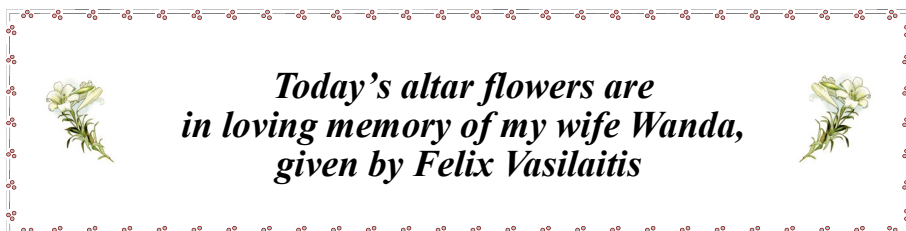

COMMUNION STATEMENT

At His baptism in the Jordan River, Jesus identified completely with us sinful beings and took His first public step toward the cross. As He did so, the Holy Spirit anointed Him, and the Father was well pleased! **THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD** thus tells us that the Holy Trinity is unmistakably for us and determined to work out our redemption. STEWARDSHIP BIBLE VERSE FOR JANUARY 9, 2022

Luke 3:21 – “Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heavens were opened.” We know why the people were baptized, but why was Jesus baptized? He didn't need repentance or forgiveness. The answer is that He did it for us. The reason God sent His Son into the world is to fulfill all righteousness for us, to do what we could not do.
