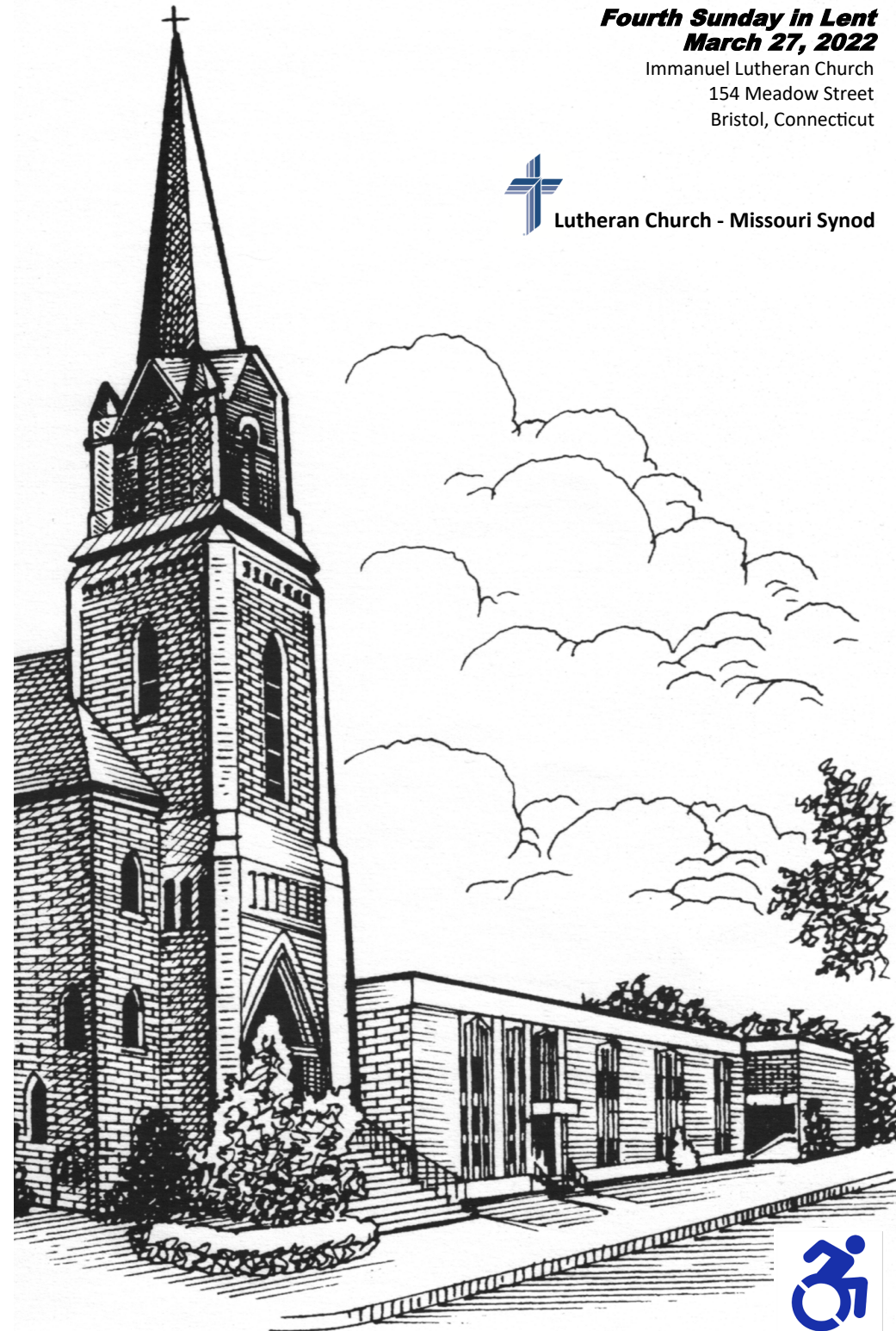

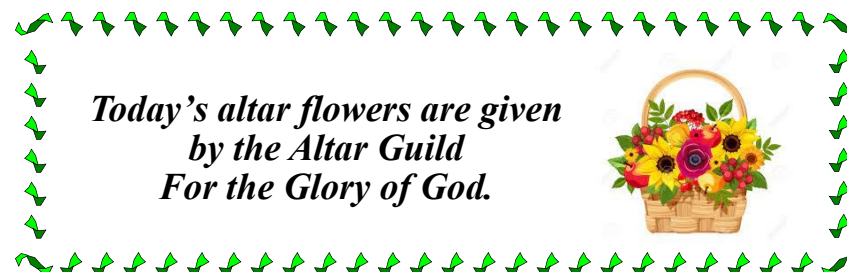
STEWARDSHIP BIBLE VERSE FOR MARCH 27, 2022
