### **Last name begins with A–G**

Bring a Salad (These are typically cold items. Some ideas: fresh green salad, antipasto platter, potato salad, gelatin salad, veggie salad, tomato salad, fruit salad, coleslaw, cold pasta salad, etc.)

### **Last name begins with H–M**

Bring a Side Dish/Casserole (These are typically warm/hot items. Some ideas: hot potato salad, tomato pie, quiche, macaroni and cheese, Mexican casserole, enchiladas, baked beans, roasted potatoes, mashed potatoes, Spanish rice, scalloped potatoes, etc.)

### **Last name begins with N–Z**

Bring a Dessert (Any dessert is fine. However, please name the dessert and note on the label if the dessert contains peanuts/peanut butter/any other nuts OR if gluten-free. This will help those with allergies to select safe foods when choosing their treats.)

### **IMPORTANT NOTE**

While this is a free event, you **MUST** officially sign up yourself or your family for the picnic so we know how many people are attending. You can do this on the signup sheet located on top of the Christian Mart glass display case. And, if you know what dish you are going to make/bring, please note that as well, as it would be helpful for our picnic planners to know that in advance.
