

COMMUNION STATEMENT

On **TRINITY SUNDAY** we are reminded of the mystery and the glory of God. His thoughts are above our thoughts as far as the heavens are above the earth (Is. 55:8,9). We cannot know His mind or be His counselor (Rom. 11:34). Accordingly, we receive in faith His counsel that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is the one true God. We also receive in faith His counsel that the very body and blood of Christ are present under the bread and wine for our forgiveness. As we receive **Holy Communion** today, the whole counsel of God moves us to receive the sacrament together. For this reason, the congregations of the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod have promised to practice close communion; and <u>guests</u> desiring to commune are asked to speak with the pastor before the service.
