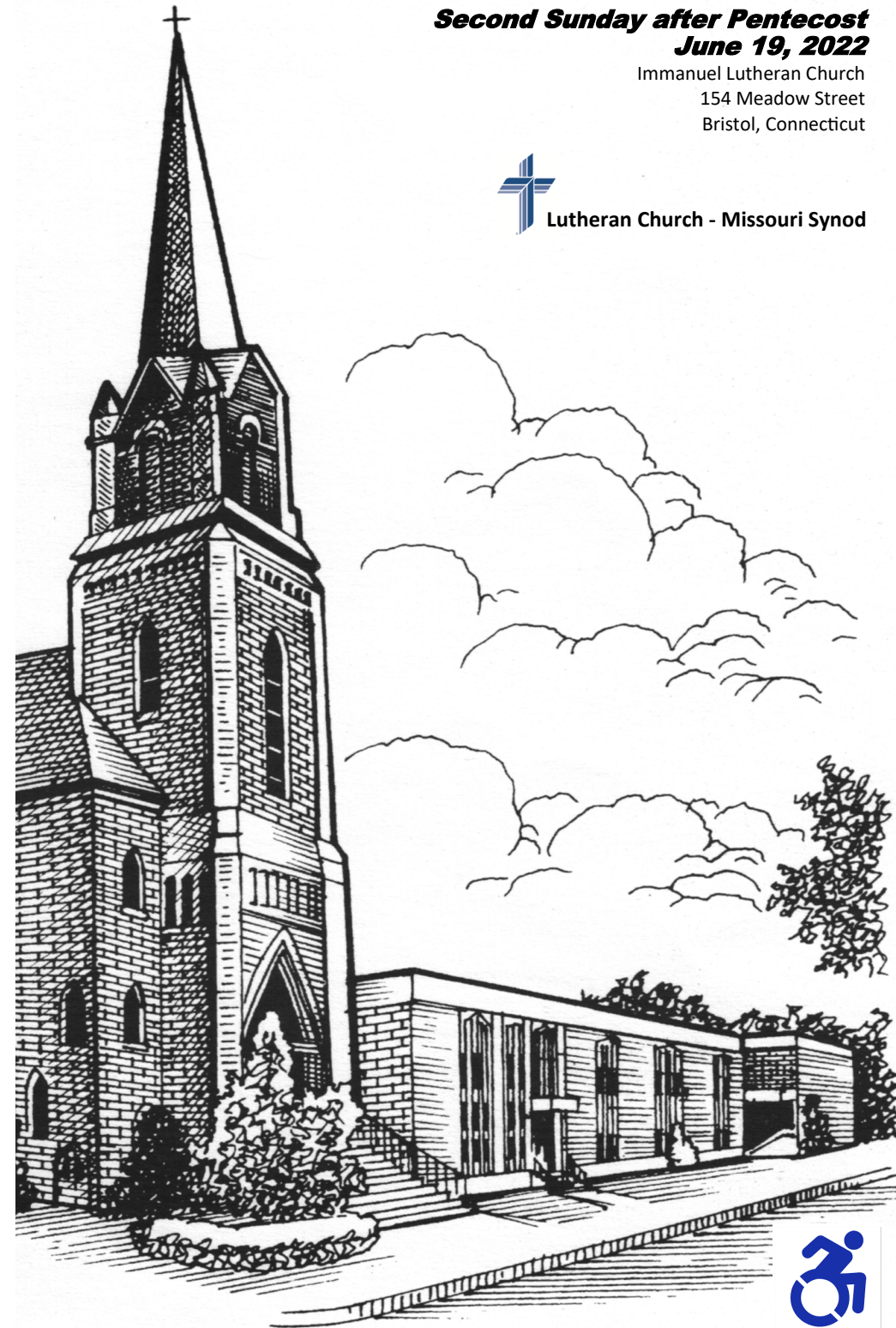

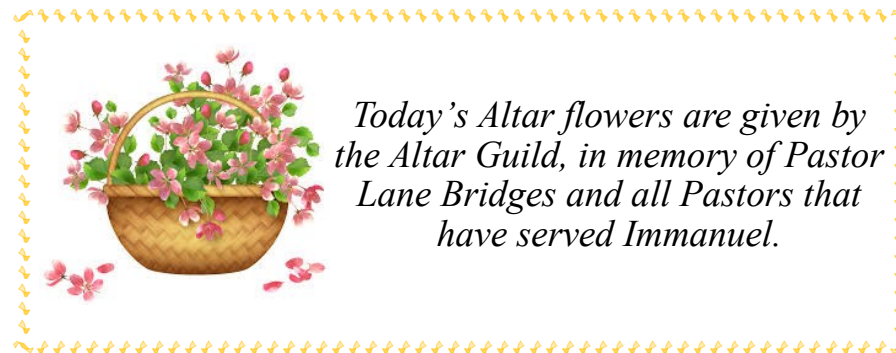
## COMMUNION STATEMENT
