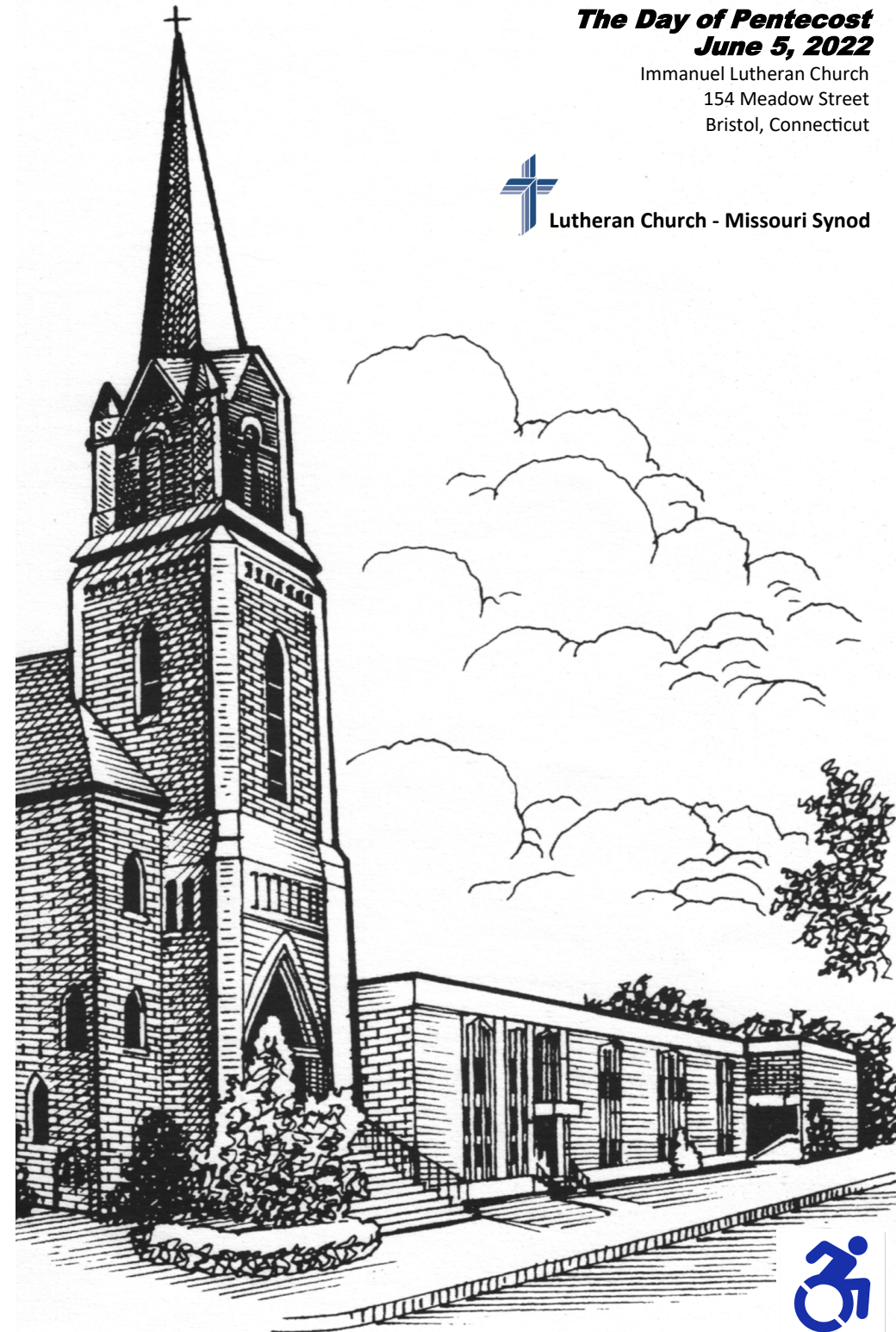

COMMUNION STATEMENT

Jesus promised that it was to our advantage that He go away and send the Holy Spirit for His Church (John 16:7). That advantage became immediately evident on **PENTECOST** as the Holy Spirit empowered the preaching of repentance and forgiveness and employed the use of baptism and the **Lord's Supper** to build the church of Christ (Acts 2). The Holy Spirit is still acting for our advantage as Christ comes to us with His true body and blood in the sacrament of Holy Communion today. Because doctrinal oneness is central to the common reception of the **Lord's Supper**, we practice close communion; and guests desiring to commune are asked to speak with the pastor before the service.

STEWARDSHIP BIBLE VERSE FOR JUNE 5, 2022

Acts 2:1 – “When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.” Notice that Pentecost is actually an Old Testament festival. It happens around the time when the wheat and oats are ready to be brought in. In the New Testament, this becomes a picture and foreshadowing of the great harvest of human-kind that God means to bring in through the preaching of His Word. God gives the seed, and God brings about the harvest through the work of His Church.
