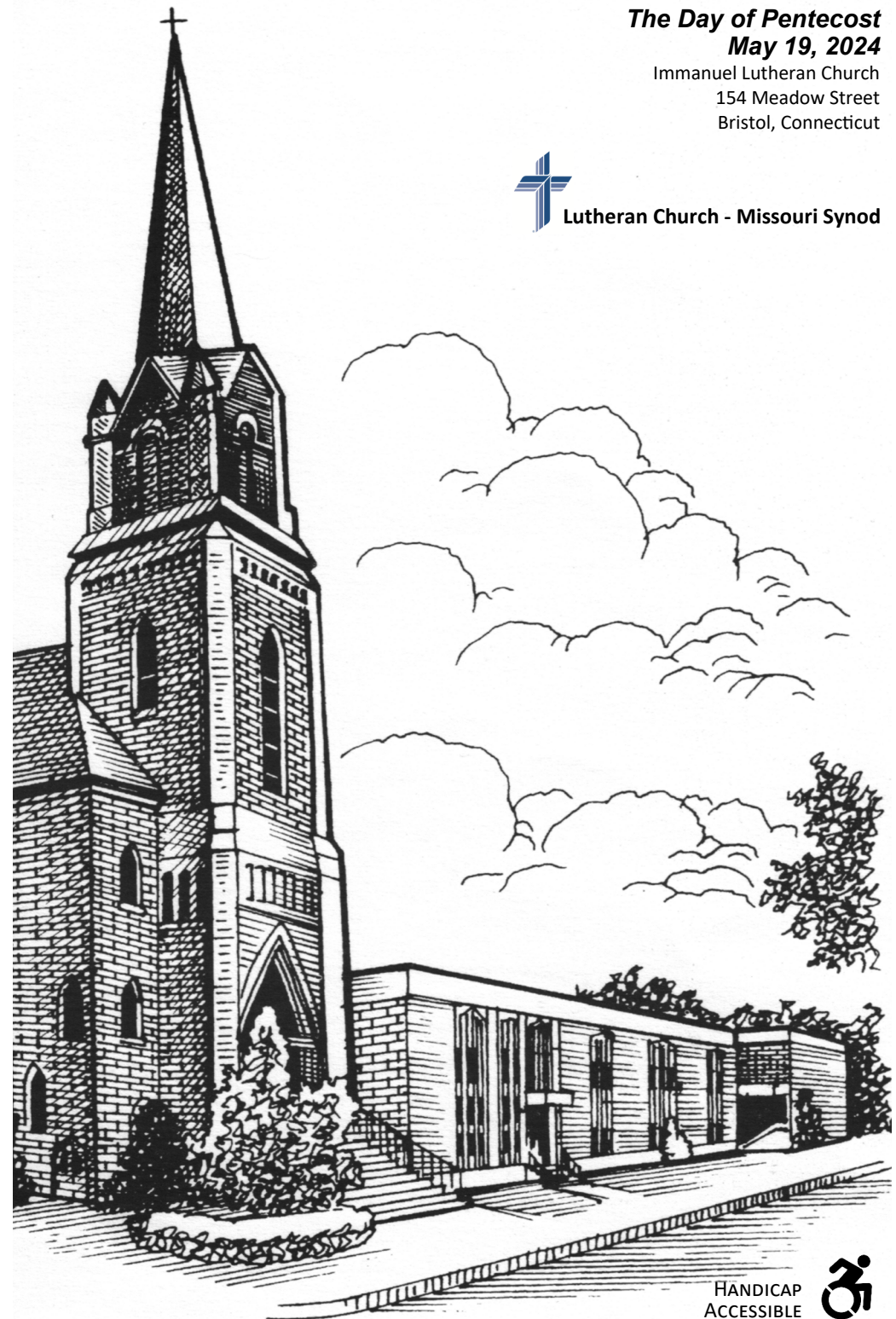

Jesus promised that it was to our advantage that He go away and send the Holy Spirit for His church (John 16:7). That advantage became immediately evident on **PENTECOST** as the Holy Spirit empowered the preaching of repentance and forgiveness and employed the use of baptism and the **Lord's Supper** to build the church of Christ (Acts 2).
