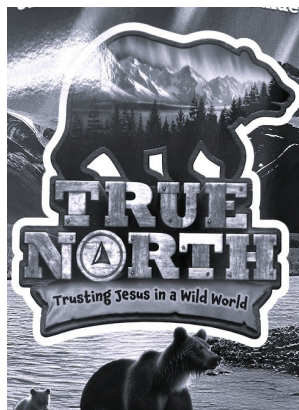
THURSDAYS CHURCH HISTORY AND SPECIAL LUNCH
