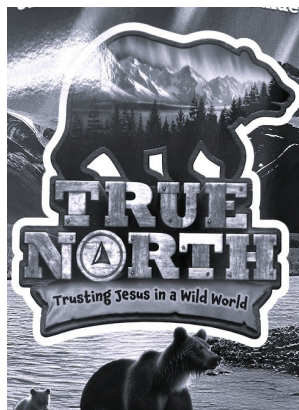


Come and join a group to sew together. No talent

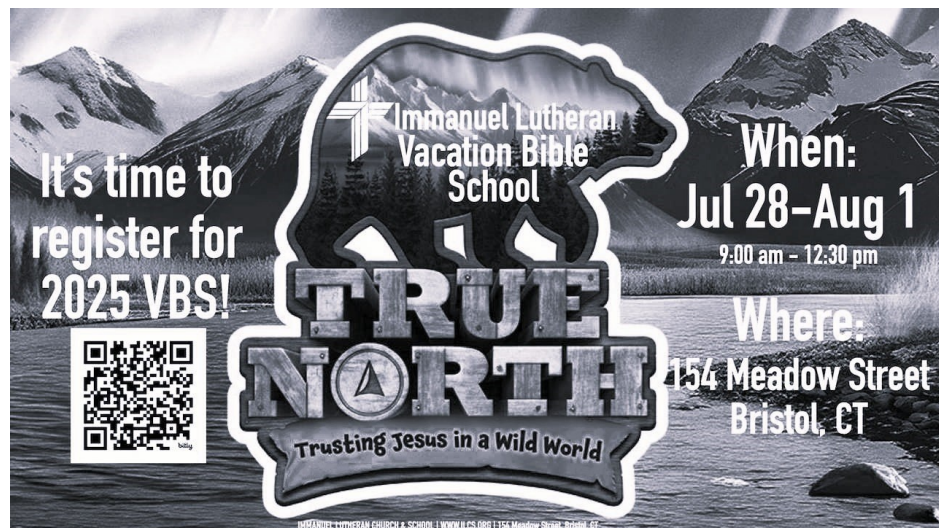


True North- Trusting Jesus in a Wild World VBS at ILC- July 28- August 1, 2025
