COMMUNION STATEMENT

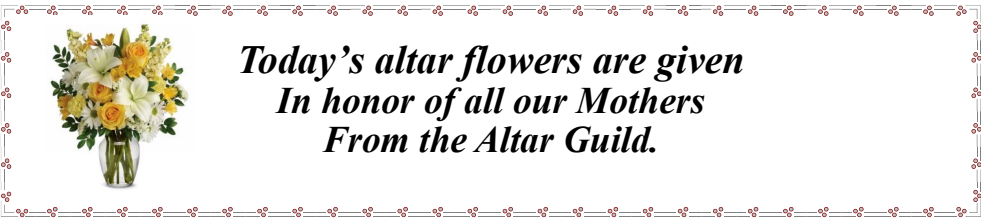
