COMMUNION STATEMENT

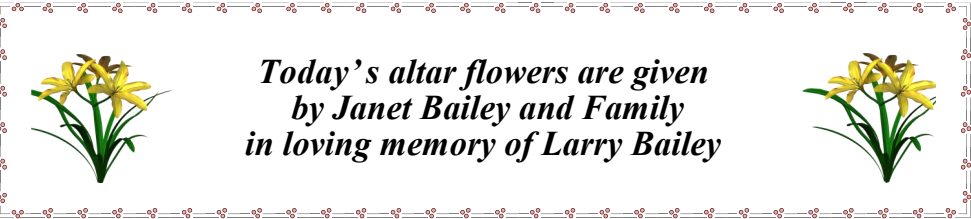
