

COMMUNION STATEMENT

The **Sacrament of the Altar** is the true Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, instituted by Christ Himself for us Christians to eat and to drink (Luther's Small Catechism). As we receive the **Lord's Supper** together, we bear witness to our unity in faith and doctrine (1 Corinthians 10:16-17). For this reason, the congregations of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod have promised to practice Closed Communion.

Guests are asked to speak with the pastor before approaching the Communion rail for the first time. Children and adults who are not eligible for the Holy Communion may cross their arms, placing both hands on their shoulders, to indicate they would like to receive a blessing.

STEWARDSHIP BIBLE VERSE FOR MARCH 8, 2026

Luke 11:21-22 – “When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are safe; but when one stronger than he attacks him and overcomes him, he takes away his armor in which he trusted and divides his spoil.” Jesus has disarmed Satan in a most unusual way: He has disarmed him by allowing Satan to cast all his weapons into Jesus.
